

ONLY PROPERTY OWNERS IN GOOD STANDING WILL BE ALLOWED TO USE THE DISCOUNT FERRY TICKETS

Times listed on this calendar are the first and last ferry trips from the mainland and island. The ferry departs on the hour and the half hour except when both boats are running; then departure is every 15 minutes. The times for Ferry#1 are listed first and leave from the mainland and the times for Ferry#2 are listed below #1. Note: Ferry#2 departs from the island Monday thru Friday.

UNSCHEDULED RUN is after daily schedule and is non-medical/non-emergency...

Unscheduled run is a reservation allowed only to residents in good standing and is only available for **1 hr** past last scheduled run. Resident must reserve boat by calling ferry office at least ½ hr before last scheduled run. Fee is \$50.00 for each ½ hr cash or check (plus appropriate ferry tickets) payable before boarding. Fare applies to each (2 axle only) vehicle. Attachments (trailers etc.) will incur additional matching charges. Ferry office 655-4258.

Total fare applies to each vehicle and applies only to two axle vehicle

Pre Season: April 25th – June 19th
 High Season: June 20th – September 1st
 Post Season: September 2nd – Nov 3rd

Heavy Equipment Schedule:

May – June 8:00AM-4:00PM, Mon-Fri; No Sat, Sun or Holidays
 July – Aug 8:00AM-4:00PM, Mon-Thurs, Fri 8:00AM-2:00PM, No Sat, Sun or Holidays
 Sept – Oct 8:00AM-4:00PM, Mon-Fri; No Sat, Sun or Holidays

***No heavy equipment (i.e. gravel trucks, cement trucks delivery trucks etc.) will be allowed passage after the designated hours, on weekends and the Holidays of Memorial Day (May 26), July 4th, Labor Day (Sept 1) and Columbus Day (Oct 13).**

***Exceptions – as traffic allows or with permission**

The following vehicles are to be expedited as soon as possible: USPS, Cement trucks, Pine Tree Waste (only when carrying for the Town), Store deliveries which are carrying perishable goods, Employees leaving island.

NO COMMERCIAL/CONTRACTOR VEHICLE, EMPLOYED BY OR DELIVERING TO A PROPERTY OWNER CAN USE PROPERTY OWNER DISCOUNT TICKET(S). RENTERS AND SERVICE PEOPLE ARE NOT PERMITTED USE OF OWNER DISCOUNT TICKETS.

Note: The discount tickets for Property owners in good standing are to be used for standard passenger cars, mini-vans, standard pick-ups (and smaller) and SUV's. All others will be required to use the regular ticket price based on the fee schedule. Property owners with dual wheel pickup trucks use one ticket and will be loaded as deck space allows.

PROTRUDING LOADS from any vehicle OR an OVERSIZED VEHICLE, shall REQUIRE AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE, upon the determination of the Captain. ALL TRACKED VEHICLES must be on a trailer.

*RESIDENT TICKETS CAN BE PURCHASED AT THE FRYE ISLAND TOWN OFFICE, by owners "in good standing" (A minimum of five (5) tickets per purchase).

ABSOLUTE MAXIMUM LOAD 7 yards, 4 ½ yards concrete.

SPECIAL INFORMATION

1. **USE FERRY AT YOUR OWN RISK; FERRY OPERATORS ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR VEHICLE DAMAGE.**
2. **ONCE ON FERRY, THE DRINKING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED BY STATE LAW. IN ADDITION, FOR SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS, SMOKING IS NOT ALLOWED ON THE FERRIES.**
3. **WHEN ARRIVING AT LANDING, TURN OFF LIGHTS, PULL IN MIRRORS AND WAIT FOR BOARDING INSTRUCTIONS.**
4. **ONCE ON FERRY, REMAIN IN VEHICLE; GETTING OUT OF YOUR CAR IS PROHIBITED, SET EMERGENCY BRAKE WHEN PARKED; TURN OFF ENGINE; WAIT FOR UNLOADING INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE FERRY CREW.**
5. **WHEN LEAVING THE ISLAND CALL FERRY TRAILER (655-4258) AT LEAST FIVE MINUTES BEFORE THE SCHEDULED TRIP. THE FERRY DOES NOT LEAVE THE MAINLAND WITHOUT A CALL FOR SERVICE, UNLESS VEHICLES HAVE BEEN LEFT WAITING.**
6. **NUMBER OF PEDESTRIANS ARE LIMITED TO NO MORE THAN 6 PER RUN.**

SPECIAL LIMITATIONS

1. **PROPERTY OWNER VEHICLES WHICH ARE LARGER THAN A STANDARD BODY PICK-UP OR TRUCK ARE PERMITTED ON THE FERRIES ON FRIDAYS, SATURDAYS, SUNDAYS, AND HOLIDAYS. AS DECK SPACE ALLOWS.**
2. **COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED PASSAGE TO THE ISLAND SEVEN DAYS A WEEK DURING THE PRE & POST SEASONS ONLY. HOWEVER, THESE VEHICLES WILL BE REQUIRED TO WAIT UNTIL DECK SPACE ALLOWS. NO PROPERTY OWNER WILL BE DISPLACED ON THE FERRY BY THESE VEHICLES.**
