

**WARRANT AND NOTICE OF ELECTION
CALLING MAINE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT NO. 6
BUDGET VALIDATION REFERENDUM
(20-A M.R.S. §1486)**

TO: Kenneth Young, a resident of Maine School Administrative District No. 6 (the "District") composed of Buxton, Frye Island, Hollis, Limington, and Standish, State of Maine.

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby ordered to serve upon the municipal clerks of each of the municipalities within Maine School Administrative District No. 6, namely, Buxton, Frye Island, Hollis, Limington, and Standish, an attested copy of this warrant and notice of election. Service shall be in hand within three (3) days of the date of this warrant and notice of election. The municipal clerks of the above municipalities shall immediately notify the respective municipal officers, who shall post the following warrant and notice of election:

TO: Wayne Fournier, Town Clerk of Frye Island: You are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF FRYE ISLAND:

You are hereby notified that a District budget validation referendum election will be held at Community Center, High Point Drive, in the Town of Frye Island on Tuesday, May 4, 2010 for the purpose of determining the following referendum articles:

- Article 1A: To elect a moderator to preside at said meeting.
- Article 1: Do you favor approving the Maine School Administrative District No. 6 budget for the upcoming school year that was adopted at the latest District budget meeting?
- Article 2: Do you wish to continue the budget validation referendum process in Maine School Administrative District No. 6 for an additional three years?

Informational Note:

A "YES" vote will require Maine School Administrative District No. 6 to continue to conduct a referendum to validate its annual school budget for the next three years.

A "NO" vote will discontinue the budget validation referendum for at least three years and provide instead that the annual school budget shall be finally adopted at a meeting of the voters.

The voting on Articles 1 and 2 shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls will be opened immediately after election of the moderator following commencement of the meeting at 10:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters shall hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
