

**WARRANT AND NOTICE OF ELECTION  
TO CALL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE DISTRICT REFERENDUM  
(20-A M.R.S.A. §§1351-54)**

TO: Kenneth Young, a resident of Maine School Administrative District No. 6 composed of the Towns of Buxton, Frye Island, Hollis, Limington, and Standish, State of Maine.

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby ordered to serve upon the municipal clerks of each of the municipalities within the Maine School Administrative District No. 6, namely, the Towns of Buxton, Frye Island, Hollis, Limington, and Standish, an attested copy of this warrant and notice of election. Service shall be in hand within three (3) days of the date of this warrant and notice of election. The municipal clerks of the above municipalities shall immediately notify the respective municipal officers, who shall post the following warrant and notice of election:

TO: Wayne Fournier, Town Clerk of Frye Island: you are hereby required in the name of the State of Maine to notify the voters of this municipality of the election described in this warrant and notice of election.

TO THE VOTERS OF FRYE ISLAND:

You are hereby notified that a District referendum election will be held at Frye Island Community Center, High Point Drive in the Town of Frye Island at 10:00 A.M. on September 8, 2009 for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1: To choose a moderator to preside at said meeting.

Article 2: Shall the Board of Directors of Maine School Administrative District No. 6 be authorized to issue bonds, notes and other evidences of indebtedness in an amount not to exceed \$12,821,765.00 to construct and equip additions and renovations to Hollis Elementary School on River Road in the Town of Hollis (the "Project") and to acquire and convey such real estate interests as the Board of Directors may determine to be necessary for the Project, which may include up to 40 acres of adjoining land to supplement the existing school site?

The voting on Article 2 shall be by secret ballot referendum. The polls will be opened immediately after the election of the Moderator following commencement of the meeting at 10:00 A.M. and closed at 8:00 P.M.

The Registrar of Voters will hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
