TO THE VOTERS OF FRYE ISLAND:

You are hereby notified that a District budget validation referendum election will be held at Frye Island Community Center, High Point Drive in the Town of Frye Island on Tuesday, May 13, 2008 for the purpose of determining the following articles:

Article 1A: To elect a moderator to preside at the meeting.

Article 1: Shall the Maine School Administrative District No. 6 budget for the 2008-2009 school year that was adopted at the district budget meeting on May 8, 2008 be approved?

The voting on the foregoing except Article 1A shall be by secret ballot referendum.

The polls must be opened immediately after election of the moderator at 10:00 a.m. and closed at 8:00 p.m.

The Registrar of Voters shall hold office hours while the polls are open to correct any error in or change a name or address on the voting list; to accept the registration of any person eligible to vote and to accept new enrollments.

A person who is not registered as a voter may not vote in any election.
